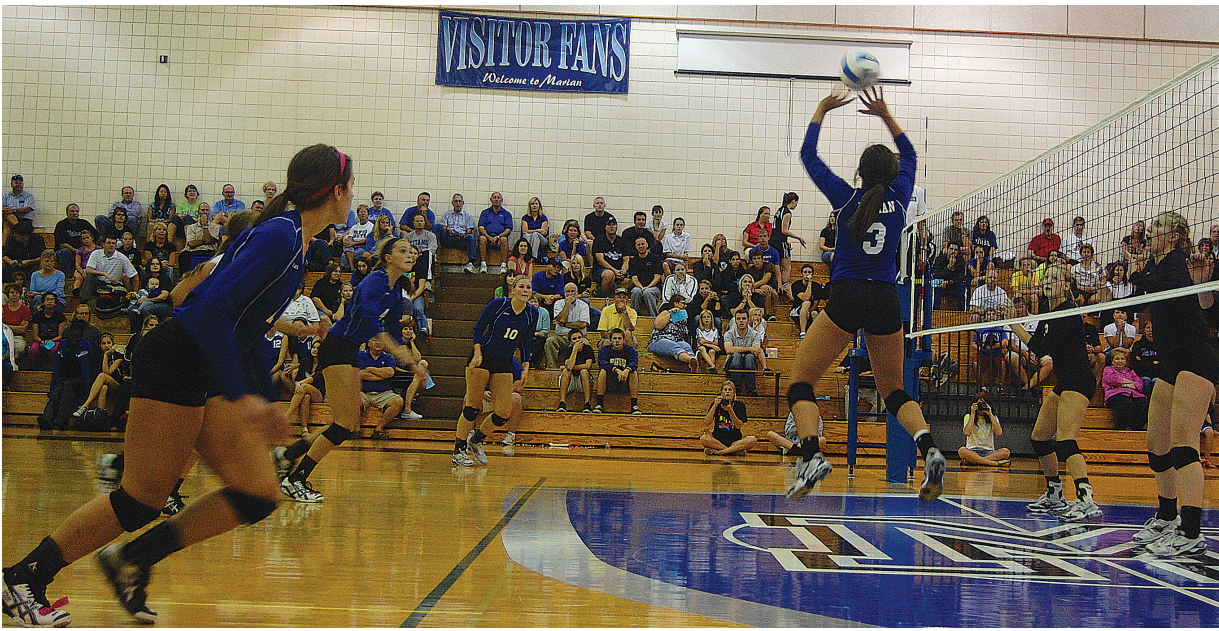


THIS MONTH IN PHOTOSS
